50+ WEDDING ANNIVERSARIES

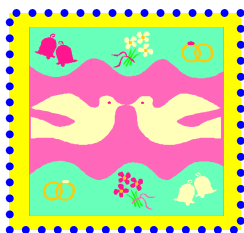
Harvy & Amy Robins will have been married for 67 years on Saturday. They were married on June 6, 1942.
