THE HEART OF THE SERVANT

"Near a park in Melbourne, Australia, there is a small statue of a donkey bearing a wounded soldier on its back. Standing beside it is another soldier, in a uniform of the First World War, with his arm around the shoulder of his wounded comrade. That man's name was John Simpson

Kirkpatrick, a plain private in the Australian army, an ordinary man who did extraordinary things in a critical situation.

"At the ill-conceived landing in Gallipoli the allied forces suffered heavy casualties. Wounded men were left to die in the field, because there was no means of transporting them to the casualty clearing station on the beach. Then this stretcher-bearer, Kirkpatrick, found a donkey and got the idea that it would make a good ambulance. For twenty-four days and nights he traveled up and down a shrapnel-swept gully transporting wounded men on the back of his donkey. He saved hundreds of lives. It was a heroic and dangerous thing to do. The Indians called him 'Bahadur', which means 'bravest of the brave'. His comrades affectionately nicknamed him 'Murphy'. Officers and men loved this familiar Good Samaritan of Shrapnel Gulley, who spoke so tenderly to the wounded and the dying, but they knew what the end would be - an enemy machine-gun bullet in his heart.

"When the officer commanding the Indian Field Ambulance received word that Kirkpatrick had been killed he did something that astonished all who knew him. He covered his face with his hands and prayed aloud, 'O God, if ever a man deserves Heaven, he does. Give it to him!'

"'Where's Murphy?' asked a British private who had not heard the tragic news. A sergeant replied, 'Murphy's at Heaven's gate, helping the wounded soldiers through.'" (The full story is told by Sir Irving Benson in THE MAN WITH THE DONKEY, 1965)
