### “By This We Know Love”

We have much to think and talk about as a church. God has blessed our congregation with growth. Men and women, young and old, in our congregation are finding ways to be involved in ministry in their daily lives. There is a lot to be thankful for here. We are blessed.

No gift, however, has ever been given to us that is greater than what God gave at Calvary. Every single thing we have and experience as good would be nothing more than a passing pleasure if it weren't for Jesus.

When Jesus humbled himself and allowed himself to be crucified in our place, he taught us many things. He taught us that God's power is not only manifested in bolts of lightning and earthquakes. Sometimes power is communicated through silence and submission. He taught us that glory and exaltation are not things we can cling to or climb over people to achieve. They are things that God gives to the humble. Jesus showed us that people—even those who really deserve to die—matter to God, and God is willing to go to great lengths to secure their love and trust.

But as we come together today, let's not think of Jesus as a poor victim of human sin or as an unwilling substitute that was required to turn aside God's wrath. Jesus said that no one could take his life from him. He laid his life down on his own accord, and he would take it up again (John 10:17-18). His sacrifice was an act of victory. His death was only the prelude to resurrection and enthronement. Let's remember that Jesus died, not because he had to, but because he loved you.

“By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers.”  
(1 John 3:16, ESV)
