In the 1970s Hal Lindsey captivated the public with his influential book, **THE LATE GREAT**

PLANET EARTH. It practically became required reading for anyone claiming to believe in the Lord's return. But, as usual, it created more questions than it answered.

The opening decade of the 21st century has witnessed a renewed interest in the end times. Thanks to the widely successful line of books by Tim LaHaye and Jerry Jenkins, the **LEFT BEHIND** series, last things are again receiving some attention. In fact, this phenomenon warranted a cover story in **TIME** magazine back in July, 2002.

Unfortunately, much of what is propagated is simply not true. Much of it is far from helpful. Here are the facts as we know them regarding the second coming of Jesus.

It will be personal. Acts 1:11

It will be a surprise. Luke 12:35-40

Every ear will hear him. John 5:28-29

Every eye will see him. Revelation 1:7

There will be a general resurrection. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

We will receive a new body. 1 John 3:2

The heavens and the earth will be destroyed. 2 Peter 3:10-12

There will be a judgment. 2 Corinthians 5:10

Vengeance will be taken on the wicked. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9

The righteous will be rewarded. Revelation 21

But, how much do we really need to know? Do we need any more details to be ready? If we had more signs, would we be more faithful? Would more reminders help us live more like Jesus?

Every Lord's Day, as the people of God celebrate the Lord's triumph over sin and death, there is a special moment of proclamation, a special reminder.
