LOVE FATHER, LOVE SON

“Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.” John 5:22-23

Jesus’ behavior had a logical explanation. Like Father, like Son. “...because whatever the Father does the Son also does.” Because He was (is) God, he acted like God. He could act in no other way. Tragically, those who watched him found his actions deplorable and sought to kill him.

But if his claim to be the Son of God is troubling to us, his declaration that he is our judge is especially upsetting. In fact, he tells us that his opinion is the only one that counts! How arrogant can a good man be?

And think about this: Jesus judges the morality of each one of us. He decides what is right and wrong. He is what it means to be good.

Folks resent that. In a culture that gloats over its freedom to decide right and wrong and that celebrates the philosophy that there is no single standard by which all are judged, Jesus is, at best, marginalized in matters of ethics and, at worst, scoffed at.

The American version of Christianity prefers a God who is more open-minded, enjoys giving good advice, and encourages everyone to be nice to each other. We would prefer that sin be reframed as something that was ‘inappropriate,’ ‘misguided,’ or ‘bad judgment.’ Even more, we prefer to see Jesus as an outstanding man we can admire and quote, but not someone who has the right to lay claim to our lives. It is no wonder that people are always going on some journey to find the ‘real’ Jesus. Clearly, they don’t like the one who appears in the Bible.

Write this on your heart: Response to Jesus is response to the Father. “He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him.” The best way to walk in God’s ways is to walk in the ways of the Son. The best way to love God is to love Jesus.
