DISCUSSION

1. We had two meetings for the VBS in the month which attendance is much encouraging; I recorded 62 teens for the first meeting and 66 for the second meetings. I continue with our study topic: - My Responsibility to the lost which will prepare the Teens to evangelize to the lost on come VBS program on June 2009.
2. We had a visitation and personal exercise, which at the end restored four backside Christians; and had two visitors who were very regular in attendance hoping to be baptize soon in Senya.
3. We also had a singing class for the youth which was also entertaining, the youth increased about 40% on the second singing class both in Senya & Bonsueku; I recorded 14 youth on the first class and 23 in the second class in Senya and 7 on the first class and 12 on the second class at Bonsueku.
4. I also preached at Nsuekyir church on the 1st and 2nd Sunday of February. on the 2nd Sunday I had a Bible Class with the Sankor Church of Christ in Winneba between 9:00am - 10 am from there came back to preach sermon at Nsuekyir both Churches have an encouraging attendance and one soul was baptize at Nsuekyir.
5. We also begin our door to door evangelism and visitation to the new church at Akraman. we spoke to about twelve prospect on the first day and two souls was

baptize to the Lord's church at Akraman, and on the second day there was no baptism but the response were very much encouraging.
