OVERVIEW OF THE MONTH

This month was very much appreciated as compared to the previous months. Two souls were baptized in Akraman during our house to house evangelism. At Nyanyano there was public education programme, house to house evangelism, visitation evening Bible classes and Sunday worship activities. These were very effectively carried out. My prayer is God should give me strength to deal with the challenges facing the church.

DETAILS OF ACTIVITIES

- **Evangelism at Akraman**

On 17th February, 2009 the four area preachers who have sworn to work together as a team and to ensure that the two new churches planted at Nsuekyir and Akraman record growth visited the brethren in the towns mentioned and also went for house to house evangelism. This resulted in the baptism of two souls into the Akraman church. I personally went to Akraman on the 19th February and worshiped with the brethren in the church as planned.

- **Public Education Programme**

The public education has brought awareness of the existence of the church in the community as people appreciated the lessons taught during the programme. The theme for the education programme was 'Proper Use of Time'. Topics treated under this include time planning, time budgeting, time spending and time wasting. After the programme the participants were enthused and promised to turn up for such events all time.

- **House to House Evangelism**

Every Thursday in every month has been earmarked as a day for house to house evangelism. On our rounds this month, seven (7) prospects were contacted and two (2) of them worshipped with us as visitors. They promised to be regular at church all the time. There is hope that they will join the church.

- **Visitation**

This was made to brethren in the church and backslidden members in the community. Every Saturday has been set aside for this activity. I visited them and had discussions with them to be firm in their faith and also pay heed to the teachings of Christ because He cares for them. Some of them responded to the call and promised to come back to the faith.

- **Monday and Wednesday Evening Classes**

The theme for the lessons this month was 'The Differences between the Lord's Church and others'. The lesson was treated under the theme were:

- Worshipping through prayer
- Worshipping through song
- Proper Worship
- Acceptable worship must be offered in truth.

The aim of these studies was to equip members to know the reason why the church of Christ does not associate itself with other denominations and also are not tractable to their flattering words but comport themselves under the teachings and doctrines of Christ.
